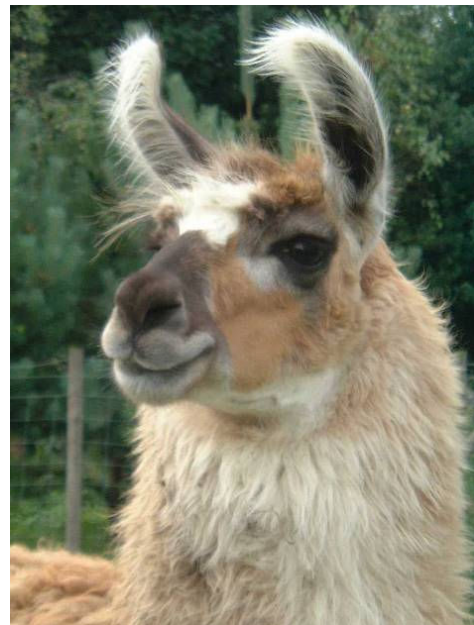
The Craft Fair runs from 10am to 5pm
